Leona Healey (Mrs Jones) for publishing her portal story independently. Fantastic job!

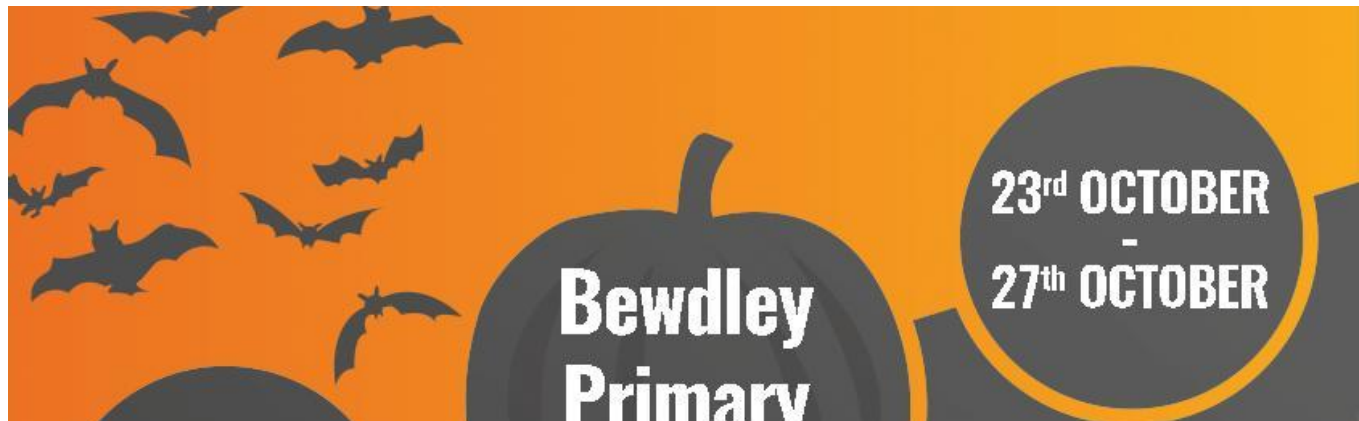
