After this, newsletters and other information will be sent to you via your child's Tapestry account, so it's very important that you activate it. The children's Individual learning plans are in place to inform and enhance the planning for the children's' individual needs and for us to work together with you to support the children, both in nursery and at home.

Achievement for All

Nursery is taking part in an Initiative which is an "Achieving Early" programme, to raise achievement by giving the youngest of our school children the best educational opportunities possible. It focuses on improving the achievement, access and aspirations of all children at the start of their journey in education.

An invitation from your child and their keyworker to come to a "Time to Talk" will be given to you over the coming weeks so that we can all share experiences and celebrate the achievements your child is making at nursery and at home.

We will be inviting the parents of the youngest children to begin with so we can incorporate the 2 Year check into the conversation. We will then invite the parents of the children who will be going into the 3-4 Nursery in the New Year.

If you have any questions regarding this, please do not hesitate to come and speak to Mrs. Downes about it.

May I also remind you:

- It is school Policy to have water only in the children's bottles. The children can have squash or cartons in their lunch boxes.
- If you haven't already contributed to snack and cooking could I take this opportunity to remind you so that we can continue to provide fruit for the children during Snack Café time. **Although these contributions are voluntary, without them we will not be able to provide our daily milk, fruit and toast.** We ask all families to make a voluntary contribution of £1.00 per week. You are welcome to pay this on a half termly, termly or yearly basis.
