There will now be two Nursery and Reception Christmas performances, Tuesday 5th and Wednesday 6th December, both at 9.30am. More information will be sent home soon.



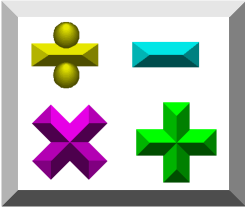

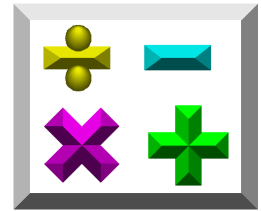


Maths News
