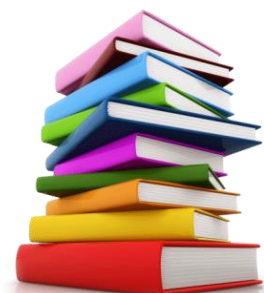
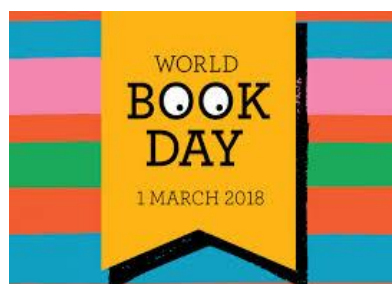
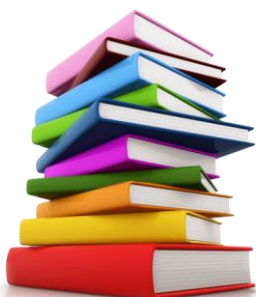

Tyler Capewell (Mrs Page) for being an absolutely amazing and helpful 'forest school-er!'

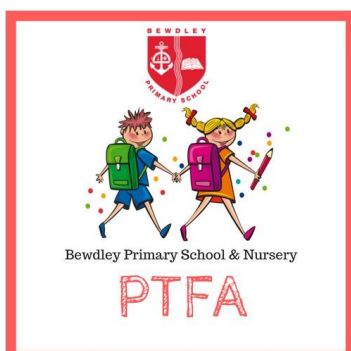
Lexie Dakin (Mrs Jones) for being an absolute superstar. Working so hard all half term. Fabulous!
