



After School Clubs

Clubs will start the week commencing Monday 23rd April 2018. **Please complete the attached form and return to school by 3.10pm MONDAY 26TH MARCH 2018.** Please tick the clubs you wish your child to join. A note will be sent home on Wednesday 28th March to let you know whether your child has a place. We will also put club costs on your 'Parent Pay' which will need to be paid before your child starts the club. If payment is not complete before the club starts your child will be unable to attend.

We are delighted with the after school clubs so far this year and will be continuing our structure for next term. All after school clubs will finish at 4.15pm. Teachers give up their free time to run a club and are not paid. Fees from the clubs will cover the cost of providing an external provider and other club costs (eg gymnastics membership/badges, sports equipment, transport to competitions, musical instruments and much more.

RASCALS

Children who go to RASCALS after a club will pay £2.50 for the club and the £4.50 fee for the 2nd RASCALS session from 4.20 – 5.30pm.

Pupil Premium children will be given £25 to spend on after school clubs each term.

Payment for clubs

All fees for clubs will be payable on line at Parent Pay. Please complete the booking form to select the clubs your child would like to join and once you have received confirmation you will be invoiced via Parent Pay and this will be the only way you can pay. If you need any help with your Parent Pay account please contact the school office. There is a computer in the school office you can use if you are unable to access the internet at home.

Sports Kits

Please ensure your child has a sports kit in school on their club day, rather than use their PE kit. Most sports clubs take place outside, even in wet weather. Sports kit should include warm clothing including jogging trousers, a jumper / sweat shirt and trainers.

Number of children within a club

Many clubs have a maximum number of children that can attend. Clubs may not take place if there are not enough children to make it worthwhile.

Reply Slips

A reply slip will be sent home on Wednesday 28th March 2018 to let you know whether your child has a place. You will need to pay via 'Parent Pay' before the club starts. **Your child will not be able to attend the club if payment is not made by Friday 20th April 2018.**

Club Commitment

After school and lunchtime clubs are carried out for 10 weeks, by staff members or instructors from outside agencies. A payment of £25 will have to be made through 'ParentPay' before the club starts. If your child changes their mind or doesn't attend the club then a refund will not be made.



Club information

Yoga

Mrs Mountain, Mrs Trow and Mrs Bennett will begin a yoga club. Yoga is an ancient form of exercise that focuses on strength, flexibility and breathing to boost physical and mental wellbeing. The main components of yoga are postures and breathing. It is also a safe and effective way to increase physical activity, especially strength, flexibility and balance.

Dodgeball

Mr Morris will create an energetic and exciting dodgeball club. This is a fast flowing game which will allow children to develop a number of throwing, catching and dodging skills whilst developing team work and tactics.

Girls Football

Mr Pritchard will run a BPS Girls Football Club. Children will develop many skills including ball control, passing technique, spatial awareness, dribbling and shooting techniques.

Drama

Mrs Westbury will be carrying out a drama club. Children will develop many acting skills including communication skills, positive and social interaction, increasing physical control and teaching children how to listen and respond appropriately.

Choir

Mrs Dunn and Miss Bradley will run Choir every week. This will involve the children singing a variety of songs. It will also prepare children for performances in school and the wider community.

Bewdley Kawa Club

This exciting Japanese language club will continue with Misa Lyon, a Japanese tutor who lives locally. This club will enrich children in Japanese culture, language, customs and music.

Languages

Mrs Walter will continue teaching a variety of languages including Chinese, German, French and many more. Children will explore new words and phrases across the world.

Newspaper

Miss Jones will continue to carry out a newspaper club where children will make amazing headlines for a BPS paper across the school. Children will develop writing skills and take on a role as a journalist. Children will be selected from KS2 classes.

Chess

Mrs Moore will continue to run a Chess Club every week. This will allow children to understand the basic moves and rules of the game. They will also be able to take part in competitions against each other.

Eco Club

Mrs Woodward will continue working with the Eco group towards more Eco awards for the school. Children have been selected from KS2.

Gym

Mrs Harding, a Wyre Forest gymnastic instructor, will continue to carry out a gym club every week. Children will develop balance and gymnastic skills. They be working towards different badges and awards.

Craft Club

Mrs Humphrey and Mrs Tench will continue to run a craft club. Children will take part in artistic and creative projects using a range of medias and materials.

P4C (Philosophy for children)

Mr Cottrill will be starting a P4C club. This is a movement that aims to teach reasoning and argumentative skills to children. It is a wonderful way of bringing teachers and children together to discuss things that matter. It has many benefits for both groups and allows children to express their views.

Maths Master Class

Mrs Woakes will continue to run a Maths club with selected children developing some fantastic maths skills.

Recorders

Mrs Powell will be starting a KS2 recorders club. This will develop their musical skills through games and playing musical pieces. The children will be taught to read musical notation within this club. Recorders can be loaned from school at no extra cost.

Magical Music

Mrs Winscom will be starting a music club for Year 2 children. They will be singing a range of songs, which will include lots of movements and play musical games to support the children's learning of music in KS2.

Athletics















Direct Sports coaches will be starting an athletics club. This club will involve children developing running, throwing and jumping skills through a range of activities including long jump, javelin and sprinting.

Tag Rugby

Direct Sport coaches will be starting an energetic Tag Rugby club. They will develop many rugby skills including ball control, tackling skills, perseverance, ability to work as a team, courage, calmness under pressure.

Rounders and Kwik Cricket

Direct Sport coaches will start a rounders and kwik cricket club. This will be a fast pasting club and is designed to introduce children to the game of rounders and cricket. It is a fun, fast, safe and an exciting game that has been designed so that anyone can play the game.
