Toast

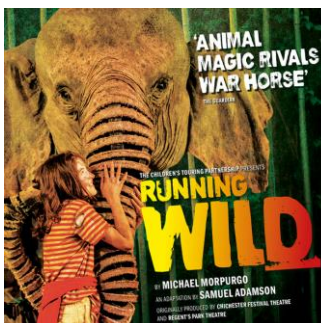

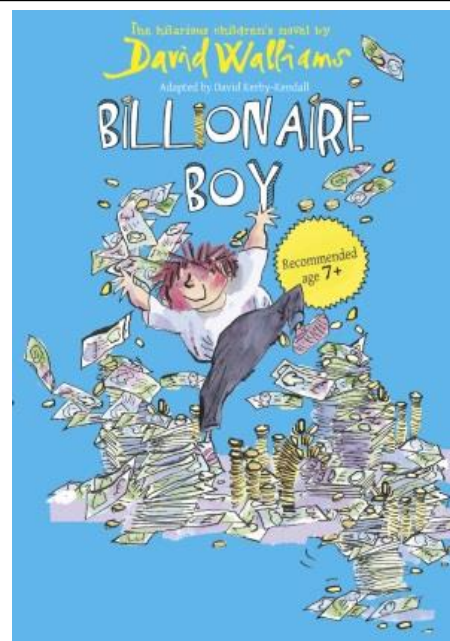
