As you will have read in the newsletter, next week, across the school, we are celebrating Community Week which is focussing on exploring and celebrating a variety of different aspects of our various communities.

In LKS2, we are going to investigate how we can help our community by improving our environment both inside and outside school. As part of this, we are planning to take the children on a short walk into Bewdley and back along the river on **Monday, 12th June**. The children will only be gone for a short time, so normal school uniform and weather-appropriate coats and footwear are all that they will need on Monday. School lunches will continue as normal.

On **Wednesday, 14th June**, we would love for you to join us for a shared breakfast as we continue to widen our school community. The breakfast will be in the school hall from 8:35 to 9:15. Sign-up sheets for breakfast donations are now available in each classroom. Visitors are very welcome to then pop into classrooms to read with their child until 9:45, if they would like to do so.

On **Friday, 16th June**, we will be heading back out into the community again to help with a litter picking exercise. The children will be constantly supervised by adults, advised in advance about the kinds of litter we'll be removing and also provided with high visibility vests, gloves to wear and litter pickers. We would also like the children to come to school wearing old clothes on the Friday.
