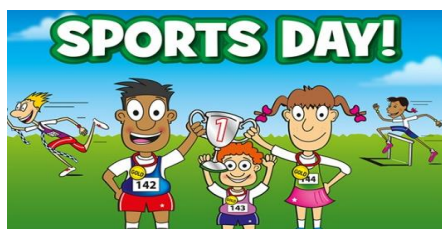
### **What does my child need to wear?**

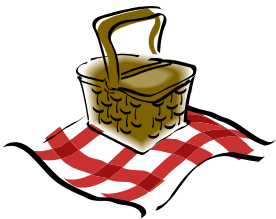
