Please can all hired musical instruments be returned to school by Friday 13th July and make sure any outstanding accounts are settled.



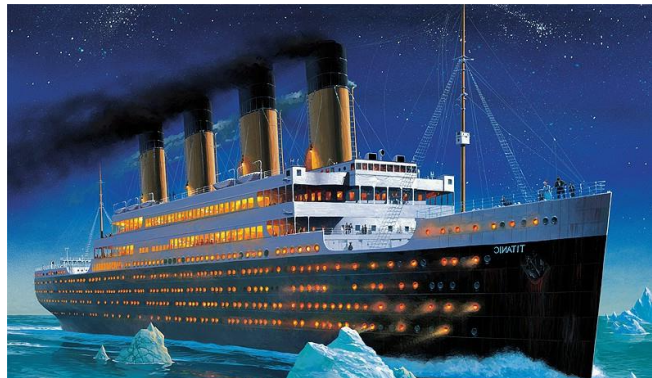
PE Kits
