School Places at Bewdley Primary School

Due to a number of families relocating away from Bewdley, a limited number of spaces has become available. These are in Reception for September 2018 and some other year groups. If you know any families who are looking for a new school please ask them to contact the school office ASAP.



Nursery Places at Bewdley Primary School

If you are looking for a small, nurturing nursery with caring staff for your 2 or 3 year old, please ask to speak to Mrs Dunn or Mrs Downes. 2 year old funded places are available, offering up to 15 hours a week. If your child is not eligible for 2 year old funding, sessions cost £15 per 3 hour session, with a minimum of 2 sessions offered per week.

The nursery is open from 9am-3pm on Tuesdays and Wednesdays, and 9am-12 midday on Thursdays.

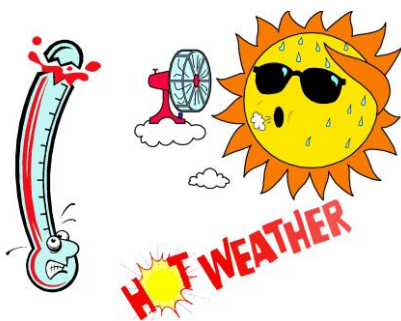
