Parking and the use of the lay-by

As you have been made aware this week, there have been some changes to the lay-by usage.

Morning drop-off

The lay-by is available for parent use before school, until 9:05.

This area is for drop-offs only. This means that parents are not allowed to leave their vehicles to supervise children into school. If you are unable to simply drop off your child, need to speak to a teacher or have a query at the school office, you will need to find a legal parking space along the roadside. Any cars in the lay-by after 9:05 are at risk of being blocked in until 4:30.

Afternoon pick-up

The lay-by is closed to parents.

The lay-by will not be available for parents to park in, pick-up or drop-off until approximately 4:30.

These changes have been put in place due to the continual misuse of the previous arrangements by a very limited number of parents. The use of the lay-by is being discussed at a Governors meeting on Monday, 9th July. If you would like your opinions to be shared at this meeting, whether in favour of or against the recent changes, please put your comments in writing to the school office or by email to governorclerk@bewdleyprimary.worcs.sch.uk before 6:30pm on Monday, 9th July.

These changes to parking should not impact on the lateness of children in the mornings or parents in the afternoons.

The school gate opens in the morning at 8:25am. Classroom doors are then open from 8:35am – 8:45am.

School finishes at 3:10pm. Please adjust your plans accordingly.

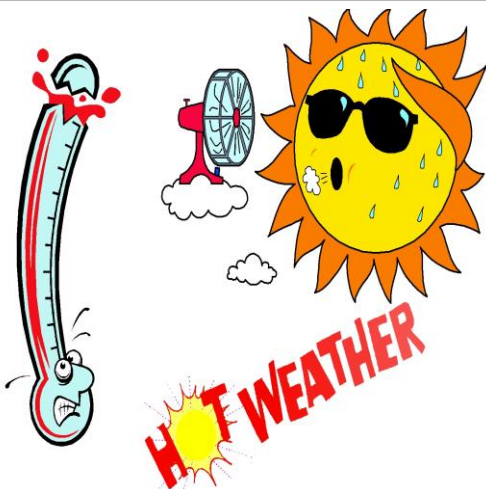
Please note that although the weather is hot children are still required to wear a suitable long sleeved top and long trousers along with a sunhat.
