### Maths Open Week at Bewdley Primary.

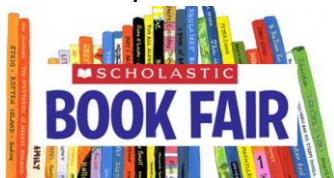


Thank you to everyone who came along and joined in with a maths lesson this week. We hope you found it helpful and went home more aware of how you can help your child with Maths.

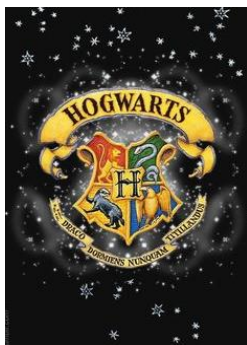
### The Scholastic Book Fair, 26<sup>th</sup> – 29<sup>th</sup> November
