We are so excited about the upcoming Key Stage Two visit to Birmingham Repertory Theatre on Thursday, 20<sup>th</sup> December. What a way to round off a fantastic autumn term!

As we sent off the initial information back in October, we'd just like to confirm the final details of the day.

**Please note that if you have not yet made a donation towards the cost of your child's ticket using ParentPay, consent has not be given for them to attend.** Contact the office as soon as possible if you are unable to make a payment but still wish for them to be part of this amazing experience.

If your child is not going on the trip, the school must be informed in advance as all teaching staff from Key Stage Two will be on the trip and alternative provision will need to be arranged for the afternoon session. All children will need to be in school on this day, even if they are not taking part in the theatre visit.



## What do they need to wear?

Come to school in the morning wearing non-uniform.

## What do they need to bring?

We'll be eating lunch at school. However, no hot dinners will be available on the day and so all children will need a packed lunch. They do not need to bring any money. An additional afternoon snack will be provided by the school and dietary requirements will be provided for.

## When are they leaving?

We'll be leaving school at approximately 1:00pm.

## What time will they be back?

Well, we're aiming for 6:30pm back at school. However, please keep close to your phones as we'll send an update as to our arrival time if it is wildly different. (Sadly, we cannot control the traffic around Birmingham during rush hour, the week before Christmas!)

## Where do I collect my child from?

As we have 180 children on the coaches and it will be dark, we will take all children back into school. **They'll then be dismissed from their classrooms as usual so please wait outside your child's classroom door as usual - do not wait in The Bewdley School car park.** If your child is going home with another parent or with somebody who does not usually collect them, please ensure that you notify their class teacher. Due to the time of the return, we would like all children to be collected by an adult rather than walking home.
