Lexie D (Rowling) for improved effort and enthusiasm with her AR reading.

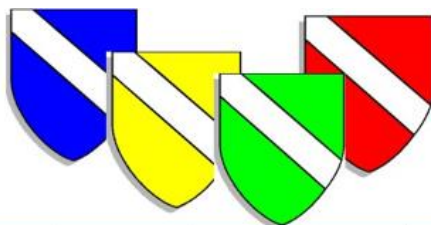
Keelie J (Lewis) for her perseverance and careful thinking during fraction work.
