Harry C (Morpurgo) for showing enthusiasm for everything he does, especially during our trip to the Wyre Forest.

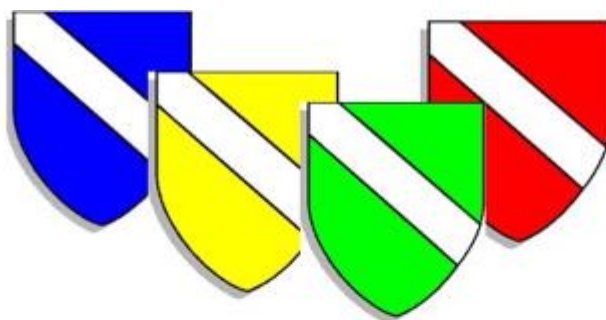
Jacob P (Dahl) for a fantastic burst of enthusiasm for reading this half term – keep it up!

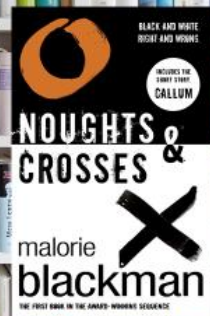
