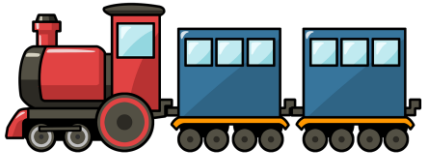

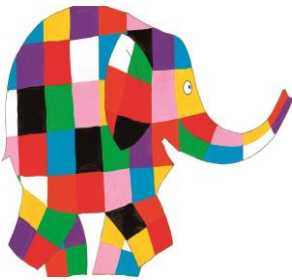

Olivia M (Dahl) for her brilliant creativity and planning for her bug hotel she has made as part of our Wondland Wonder topic.

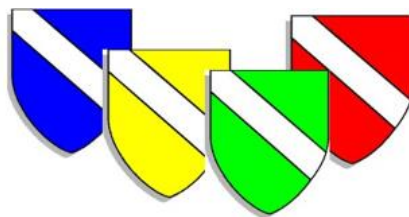
Maya W (Rowling) for always being a great helper in and out of lessons.
