



Dear Parents,

Thank you for the **100% positive response** to our trip to Warwick Castle. We have booked the trip for **Wednesday 18th September 2019**. It is now available to pay on Parent Pay.

More information will be sent when we return in September. This is a copy of the original letter with the details so far.

In the Autumn Term, we will be studying a topic called 'Stories and Shields'. As part of looking at knights, castles, dragons and princesses, we would like to take the children to Warwick Castle. During our visit, we will explore the Great Hall, get lost in the Horrible Histories Maze, walk through the Peacock Garden, watch the trebuchet in action and explore the top of the castle and see how it was defended.

We will also take part in the 'Stories and Shields' workshop. The children will meet a real princess or prince, who will introduce them to the idea of heraldry. They will then have the opportunity to design their own heraldic symbols. They are also treated to a story involving bravery, a quest and, of course, a dragon. Children can then take their wooden shield back to class/home which is supplied as part of this package.

The cost for this whole day will be **£19.65**.

The breakdown (with the school subsidising the coach) for each child is:

- £6.50 – entry fee
- £6 – Stories and Shields workshop
- £7.15 – coach travel

We think it will be a fantastic day out and the trip will help the children to be immersed in our topic.
