










*We are all excited about all the changes and the upcoming year.*

## Reminders regarding the start and the end of the school day and Parking

School starts promptly at 8.45am, the school gate is opened at 8.25am and classroom doors open at 8.35am. The gate is locked again at 8.45am. If you are running late children must enter school via the main reception.

School finishes at 3.10pm. Lessons run until this time so please allow time for children to gather their belongings before being dismissed.

Please remember to park legally, responsibly and with consideration for our neighbours, ensuring driveways, pavements and verges are not blocked. The lay by at the front of school can only be used at the start of the school day as a drop off zone only. Please do not park and leave your vehicle unless it is in one of the marked bays. It is unavailable from 9.15am to 4.30pm. This is for the safety of pedestrians and other road users.

We are very aware that there is very little parking around the Bewdley Schools, parking is available at the Leisure Centre or Blackstone Car Park, with a short walk to the school.
