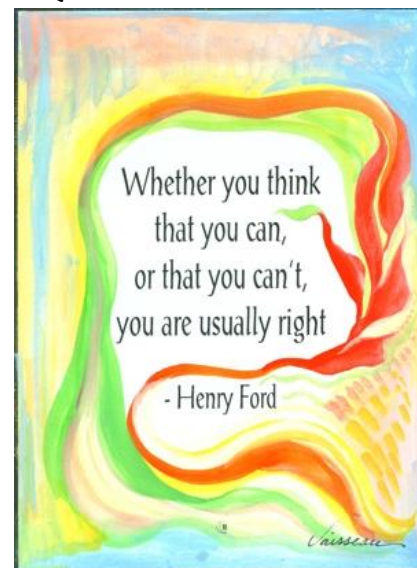

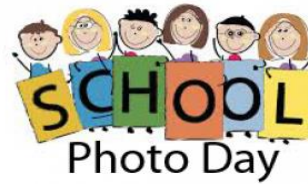

Following feedback from last year's disco we have made a number of changes to how we are running this year's event.

Most significantly, we will be holding two separate Halloween discos. The first one for Year Two and below and the second one for Year Three and above. It will not be possible to pay on the night. All tickets must be bought via ParentPay before 3:30 on Friday 18th October. We're still including a bag of sweet goodies and a drink in the price

All of the additional games and activities are now included in the entry fee too which is £5. No additional pocket money will be needed. (We won't run short on goodie bags, due to the pre-payment system.) * To reduce the amount of time Key Stage Two children will spend queuing, all children who have purchased a ticket in advance will be given a named ticket before the event. They can then hand this in as they enter the building, rather than being signed in. Children with specific dietary requirements will have a different coloured entry ticket to alert PTFA volunteers that they will need a specific goodie bag.
