<p><b>How do I buy tickets?</b></p> <p><i>On Friday, 15<sup>th</sup> November, at 6pm, tickets will be released on ParentPay.</i></p>	<p><b>How many tickets are available?</b></p> <p><i>There are 150 tickets available for each screening.</i></p>	<p><b>When is the deadline for buying tickets?</b></p> <p><i>The deadline for buying tickets is Friday, 29<sup>th</sup> November. However, if all 300 tickets have been sold before then, we will close the deadline earlier.</i></p>	<p><b>What if I miss the deadline?</b></p> <p><i>You will be unable to purchase a ticket.</i></p>
<p><b>Will there be a waiting list if the tickets sell out or if I've missed the deadline?</b></p> <p><i>No. If children are unable to make it on the day, we will advise parents to exchange tickets between themselves. However, we will need notification of any ticket swaps before the event. Food orders cannot be changed.</i></p>	<p><b>Why aren't you doing a themed activity night like the last couple of years?</b></p> <p><i>As much as we've loved The Polar Express and Harry Potter events from the last few years, they take a huge amount of time, energy, organisation and people power! We want to keep our events fresh and felt that it was a good time for a change. However, we would recommend the earlier screening for the younger pupils wherever possible.</i></p>	<p><b>Is this film suitable for my child?</b></p> <p><i>It is the responsibility of parents/carers to ensure that this film is appropriate for their child. Home Alone is a PG film.</i></p>
<p><b>Do they come in their pyjamas or Christmas jumpers?</b></p> <p><i>Children coming to Screening One need to bring their pyjamas or jumpers with them to change into after school. Those coming to Screening Two should come already dressed.</i></p>	<p><b>Do they get an actual ticket?</b></p> <p><i>During the week beginning Monday, 2<sup>nd</sup> December, individual tickets will be sent out.
