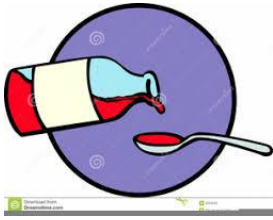
Please remember your child will need wellingtons, warm clothing and a waterproof coat unless they are borrowing a school waterproof.

Please can parent/carers refer to the school Mobile Phone policy for full details. This is available on the school website www.bewdleyprimary.co.uk and has been emailed to you.

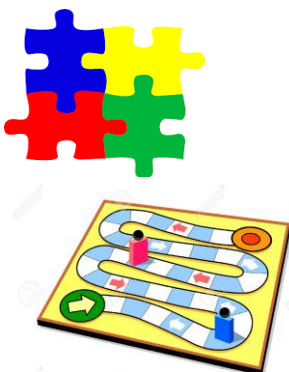
