Revised Childcare Arrangements for identified Children

We would like to thank all the parents who have managed to find alternative childcare and not brought their children to school today. We would like to remind parents that wherever possible children should stay at home. Please only send your child if it is absolutely necessary and you have **no other safe option.**

We can only provide care for a limited number of children including children who are vulnerable and children whose parents are critical to the COVID-19 response and cannot be safely cared for at home. We may need to ask for proof of your shifts to continue providing the care.

Lunch

Children will need to bring a packed lunch – no lunches available to order

Children do not need to wear school uniform but do need a coat (waterproof) and practical clothing for a variety of activities. Could they also have a pair of wellies and trainers in school at all times. It is important that they bring a water bottle that can be refilled as well.

We will provide breakfast to those arriving between 7:30 am and 8:30 am and a snack for those staying after 3:30 pm. You can also send another snack that can be eaten during the day.

We would ask that if your child has taken their learning pack home that they come back to school with it. We will be getting them to do the home learning activities that the other children are doing, along with some other fun activities to keep them entertained and occupied!
