






Maths Homework activities for Year 3 HT2

These are the main areas of Maths your child will be learning this half term. Occasionally your child may be given extra homework to reinforce an area of Maths they need more practise with.

<p>I can count from 0 in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100</p>	<p>I can recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3 and 4 tables.</p>	<p>I can write and calculate mathematical statements for multiplication and division using the multiplication tables.</p>
<p>Practise counting forwards and backwards.
