### **Reporting a positive case of Covid-19**

As with previous holidays, the school must have arrangements in place to report to the Local Outbreak Response Team any positive COVID-19 cases that were either:

- Symptomatic or
- LFD/PCR positive

on any day up to and including Sunday 30th May.

Please do not send your child(ren) to school, on the first day back after the holiday if they are exhibiting symptoms of covid (or if having been a close contact of a case in the previous 10 full days).

## Holidays

Now that restrictions are relaxing more people are beginning to take a holiday.

We realise that many people have been unable to take holidays recently and can understand that holidays are important for families but would ask that you try and book these during school holiday periods not term time as we are not able to authorise absence without there being an exceptional circumstance as per government guidelines. Common examples are where parents are members of the armed forces or emergency services where leave is fixed, or where written evidence can be produced from employers stating that holiday leave can only be granted in term time dates.

Can we remind you that if your child is going to be absent from school for any reason please complete a 'Request for leave during term time' form which can be obtained from the school office. Alternatively send an email with details to [office@bewdleyprimary.worcs.sch.uk](mailto:office@bewdleyprimary.worcs.sch.uk). This needs to be done at least 3 weeks before the holiday is due to start and holidays should not be booked until authorisation is given. Every application will be considered on its own merits. A decision will be provided in writing. The criteria used is imposed by government legislation

## **Pupils returning from holidays outside of the UK, Channel Islands, Isle of Man and Ireland**

### Red Listed countries

Pupils or staff who have been to any of these countries in the 10 days prior to entering the UK:

- Must not attend school until:
  - They have completed 14 days in a managed quarantined hotel and taken 2 COVID-19 tests with negative test results. They should quarantine with a parent or legal guardian, not at home.

### Amber Listed countries

Pupils or staff who have been to any of these countries in the 10 days prior to entering the UK:

- Must not attend school until:
  - They have quarantined at home or in the place they are staying for 10 days
  - They have taken a COVID-19 test on or before day 2 and on or after day 8 and these are negative
  - Children aged 4 and under do not need to take the day 2 or day 8 test.

### Green Listed countries

Pupils or staff who have been to any of these countries in the 10 days prior to entering the UK:

- May return to school only if:
  - They have taken a COVID-19 test on or before day 2 after they arrive back in England which has returned a negative result (day 0 = day they arrive back in England). This should be undertaken by a COVID-19 test provider, provider lists available here: [Choose a provider for your day 2 test - GOV.UK \(find-travel-test-provider.service.gov.uk\)](https://www.gov.uk/find-travel-test-provider)
  - Children aged 4 and under do not need to take this test.
  - Pupils and staff do not need to quarantine unless the test result is positive.
  - Pupils and staff must quarantine if NHS Test & Trace informs them that they travelled to England with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19.

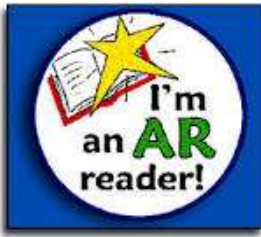

**Morpurgo** are at the top of the leader board this week with 94% success rate!

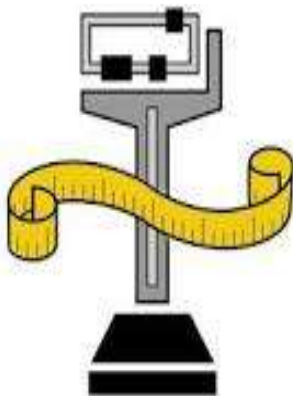
This week's most improved class is **Walliams** who have increased their success rate by 14%!
