

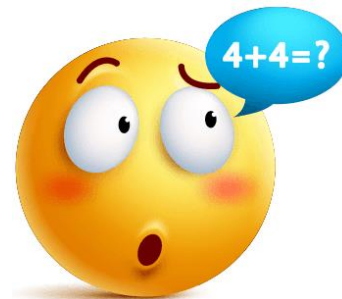
Home Learning Key Stage Two (Years 3, 4, 5 and 6)
