

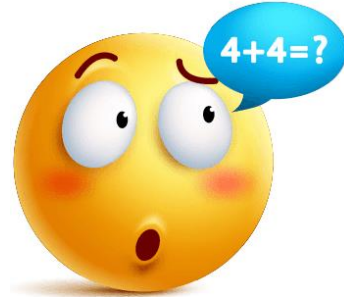
# Home Learning Year 1
