

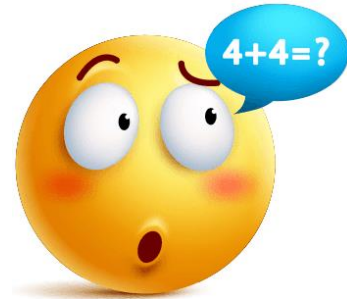
## Home Learning Year 2
