It has been a very challenging week in terms of dealing with the diarrhoea and sickness bug at the end of last week and an outbreak of Covid over the past two weeks. I apologise for the many different letters with changing advice that have come your way but it has been an evolving situation and we have had daily conversations with the Local Outbreak Response Team and consultants from Public Health. I realise this is not at all what we wanted at the start of the term and we can only hope that things improve very soon. Your understanding and support has been much appreciated even when we know that we are asking you to follow new guidance that can be very challenging and may not be what you would want for your children.

Sadly, the advice remains in place to stick with the core education and to avoid children crossing bubbles at the current time. This means that we cannot run after school clubs, tuition groups or operate Rascals again next week as well as cancelling swimming.

We will keep you posted with regard to any other changes and, hopefully, the measures that have been put in place will have the desired effect soon. I hope that all those affected by the outbreak are not poorly and make a speedy recovery.

We will move our planned Parents' Information Evening online and will send details next week about how you can access this.

As always, the positivity of the children, those learning at home and those in school, has been admirable and shows just how resilient they are.

Swimming is an expensive but very important part of the school curriculum. The cost of transport, hire of the pool and swimming instructors is considerable and we ask parents for a £15 donation towards the transport costs. This is payable via Parent Pay.
