Parking reminders

Disabled Parking



Disabled parking is extremely limited. There are only 2 disabled spaces which are available on a first come, first served basis.

Reception eye tests

A letter has been sent home with your child today with details about your child's vision screening. If you **do not** consent please return the slip to the school office.

Current isolation advice

Children aged 5 and under are not advised to take a LFD test unless they are a contact of positive case within their own household, or they develop symptoms.

Confirmatory PCR tests following a positive lateral flow device (LFD) test result were temporarily suspended from Tuesday 11 January. This means that anyone who receives a positive LFD test result will be required to self-isolate immediately and will not be required to take a confirmatory PCR test. Your child only needs to have a PCR if they have **not** had a positive LFD **but do have symptoms**.

Individuals may now take LFD tests on **day 5 and day 6** of their self-isolation period. **Those who receive two negative test results are no longer required to complete 10 full days of self-isolation.** The first test must be taken no earlier than day 5 of the self-isolation period and tests must be taken 24 hours apart. **This also applies to children under 5, with LFD testing at parental or guardian discretion.** If both these test results are negative, and you do not have a high temperature, you may end your self-isolation after the second negative test result and return to your education or childcare setting from day 6.

If children do not take an LFD test on day 5 or 6 or the results are still positive or they have a temperature, they must continue to isolate for 10 days (longer if a temperature remains)
