(We'll make sure that we keep some cakes back for children in Key Stage Two who finish at a later time.)

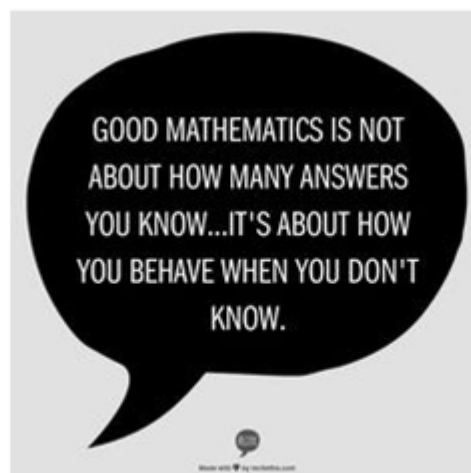
Please only send cash into school with children if absolutely necessary. We would prefer parents brought money with them at the end of the day, wherever possible.
