To celebrate The Queen's Platinum Jubilee, we are inviting all parents and carers to join us in a whole-school outdoor concert on Friday, 27th May! This will be our first whole-school event, with parents, for quite some time and we are so excited to be able to come together to recognise this milestone together.

The concert is due to start at 1:45pm and parents/carers will be allowed onto the field from 1:15pm. Due to the amount of visitors we are expecting, we'll be opening additional entrances for the event. Further information will be given closer to the time. We anticipate that the concert will have finished by 3pm and children can be collected from their classrooms as usual.

Each child will be allocated 2 tickets for the event. If you would like additional tickets, a waiting list will be available through the school office, when spare tickets are returned. Physical tickets will be sent home during the week beginning 16th May.

To ensure that the concert is a success, we have hired a professional company to provide a high quality sound-system for the day. As a result, to help cover the cost of this, we are asking parents and carers to make a suggested donation of £2.00 per ticket via ParentPay.

Parents and carers need to bring their own seats for the event—we recommend camping-style chairs, in case the field is a little on the muddy side. Please don't bring picnic blankets as you won't be able to see anything from the floor! The show will go on, regardless of the unpredictable British weather, so please come prepared for both heatwaves and snowstorms!

Over the next few days, teachers will be sending letters home to let you know what your child needs to wear for their part of the concert and we thank you in advance for your support with this.
