



### Spending Money

We have recently discovered that all food outlets at Legoland Windsor are cashless, so food can only be purchased using a card. If children have their own debit cards, then they will be able to use the food stalls.

If they would like to buy lunch while they are there but they only have cash, a member of staff will pay on their behalf and take the cash in exchange. Please send some change too, if possible. Please be aware, though, that staff will not be able to pay for food if pupils don't have the cash to give them on the day.



The main Legoland shop is mainly cashless but does have a 'Cash Only' till, so children will be able to buy things from the main store. Please see below for a guide to the prices of items in the shop. We recommend that children buy smaller souvenirs, rather than big LEGO sets.

If children are buying lunch and wish to buy a souvenir too, we would advise around £20 spending money at the most. Children will be looking after their own money on the day.



### Phones

Please do not send phones with the children. We'll update you with travel arrangements using the school's text system. We will take lots of photos to share afterwards, so children won't need to take their own and can concentrate on just having fun!

### Contacting the Year 6 Team

If you need to contact the Year 6 team during the school day, please get in touch with the school office who will forward any messages to us. If you need to get a message to us after 4pm, please email Miss Bradley and Mrs Woodward, who will check their messages regularly. Please do not email about arrival times, though—we'll text everyone together.

### Food and Drink

Lunch can be either a packed meal or bought from the venue (see 'Spending Money' note). Even if buying lunch, we would recommend that children take a water bottle with them.

Children are welcome to take snacks and other drinks for the day too. This will be much more economical than buying them there!

We'll be having a stop-off at Oxford Services on the way home for children to eat their packed meal from home. Although we'll have time to use the toilets, children won't be able to buy food and drink at the services. Their packed evening meal can remain on the coach during the day, if it's in a separate bag.



### Non-Uniform

The children are welcome to wear non-uniform for the day and we'll take the BPS high-vis jackets with us to wear while they're there. The current weather forecast suggests that we'll be lucky with the weather but that could all change in the next week! We'll be outside for 6 hours so please apply sun-tan lotion before school, send a hat and a waterproof, just in case!

We know that lots of children are keen to go on the water rides! That's absolutely fine with us, as long as they have a change of clothes so they're not sat in soggy clothes on the way home!
