Ticket Sales

All children will initially be allocated up to 4 tickets each. To cover the cost of hiring the hall, we will be charging £4 for each ticket. These will be available to buy using ParentPay at any time, up until Wednesday, 6th July. From Thursday, 7th July, any unsold tickets will then go on sale for general release to all Year 6 parents on a first come, first served basis. Please be aware that seating is not reserved. If you have particular requirements, including the need for disabled access, please get in touch and we'll do our best to accommodate them.
