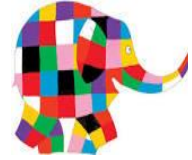
Our residential trip to Arete is fast approaching (if you just count school weeks, that is!) and we are starting to get really excited!

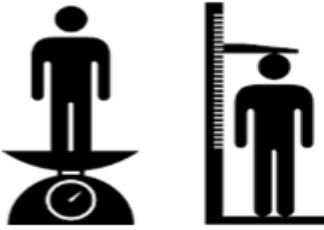
