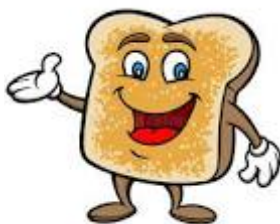
Well Done for Butterworth for last week! Congratulations should also go to Donaldson and Carroll as runners up!
