

The Tower of London Wednesday 28th June

Following on from our incredibly positive response to the Tower of London Trip, we are so excited to announce that it will go ahead on Wednesday 28th June. This will really enhance the children's Crime and Punishment topic and will be the perfect finale.

To make the most of the day, we'll be leaving school at 7:30am in the morning, so children will need to be dropped off at the main office at 7:15. We're then aiming to be back at school for approximately 8:30pm but will obviously keep parents updated with a specific arrival time.

As this is a relatively late return, children can come into school later on Thursday morning, if you choose. Anyone arriving before 10:15 will not be considered as 'late' but classes will also open at 8:35 as usual.

The price for this trip is slightly cheaper than originally suggested, coming in at £26. There is therefore an amended Promise to Pay form, alongside the permission information. This includes coach travel, entrance to the Tower of London and a workshop. Further details about the running of the day will be sent closer to the time.



Worcestershire County Museum at Hartlebury Castle

As part of our Second World War topic in the second half of the summer term, we're hoping to take Year 4 to the Worcestershire County Museum at Hartlebury Castle.

The day will include two fantastic workshops. The first looks at what life was like for evacuees, including a range of interactive activities. The other looks at life on the Home Front with activities such as rag rugging, washing and menu planning.

To aid this immersive experience, we would like children to dress up as children from the 40s. We don't expect anyone to spend of lots of money but you can hopefully 'make do and mend' with things you already have at home.

This cost of the admission fee and both workshops comes to approximately £10. To keep costs low for parents, particularly as it's not the only trip we're running this term, we're hoping to raise some money to cover the cost of the coach. Details of our fundraising 'VE Day Party', and invites for parents and carers, will be released closer to the time.

We appreciate that having two educational visits in the same term comes at a cost. However, we always ensure that any trips we plan enrich our curriculum and give children opportunities that they may not otherwise experience. We thank you for your continued support with this.
