Year 4 Trip to The Tower of London

After having been on our pre-trip visit to the Tower of London at the weekend we are now even more excited and have finalised the plans for the day itself. We were able to walk through our trip and speak to staff so that we know exactly what to expect on the day. Please be on time on the day so that we can leave promptly and ensure that if your child suffers from travel sickness, you medicate them before leaving home and give the medication for the return trip to staff to sign for.

Itinerary for Wednesday 28th June

7:15am	Children to arrive at Main School Office

11:00am	Coach Drop off at Tower of London. Children to check in, receive wristbands and join groups to begin their tower tour.

2:00 - 4:15	Tower of London Tours
4:30pm	Coach leaves Tower of London
6:15pm	Stop off at Oxford Services for picnic tea
6:45pm	Leave Oxford Services
8:00pm	(Hopefully) Arrive back at BPS

If extra toilet stops are required, we will make those decisions at the time. We'll send a text when leaving Oxford Services to give a more accurate arrival time back at school.

School Uniform Please!

The children are to wear school uniform for the day and we will also be taking the BPS high-vis jackets with us to wear while they're there. As it is difficult to rely on the weather, plan to take a sun hat in case it is hot and a lightweight water proof coat as we will be outside for some of the visit but hopefully the forecast nearer the time will be kind to us. There will be a lot of walking up and down windy staircases during our visit so please make sure the children are wearing comfortable shoes.

Food and Drink

The children will need to take two packed meals with them for the day. One that we will eat at lunchtime at the Tower and the other for our stop off on the way home.

Children are welcome to take snacks and other drinks for the day too.

We'll be having a stop-off at Oxford Services on the way home for children to eat their packed meal from home. Although we'll have time to use the toilets, children won't be able to buy food and drink at the services. Their packed evening meal can remain on the coach during the day, if it's in a separate bag.
