

It could be a look at the future of energy and how we can produce enough energy sustainably without harming the environment, or a plan to revolutionise travel and transport in your country or beyond. Your plan must be realistic, but we welcome ideas for futuristic strategies and new technologies.
- Key Stage 2 criteria: Provide your plan for **at least one geographical issue**, using annotated images, maps or diagrams.
