



Thursday, 21st December – Years 3, 4, 5 & 6

Firstly, we would like to apologise for talking about Christmas when we're only just into October! However, in order to give parents plenty of notice, we're sending out this information with 12 weeks' notice to allow for the cost to be spread if needed. On Thursday, 21st December, the penultimate day of the Christmas term, we are taking years 3, 4, 5 and 6 to the Birmingham Repertory Theatre to see one of the most popular tales of all time, *The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe*! This spectacular production will feature all of the beloved characters from the classic story, mixed with a little extra dusting of festive magic, to create the ultimate end of term treat.

To buy a child's ticket to this performance would *usually* cost £38.50. However, we have been able to negotiate a price of just £17.50 per ticket! The coach cost for this event is over £1500, however, the Bewdley Primary PTFA has kindly offered to cover the cost of the transport.

Therefore, we are able to offer this fabulous opportunity to all children in Key Stage Two for the bargain price of just £17.50 per child rather than the full cost of £45.

School dinners will not be available on this day as we'll be having an early packed lunch before we travel. We'll be leaving school at approximately 12:45pm for a 2:30pm performance and we're expecting to be back in Bewdley for approximately 6:30pm.
