Coming up in Year 2...

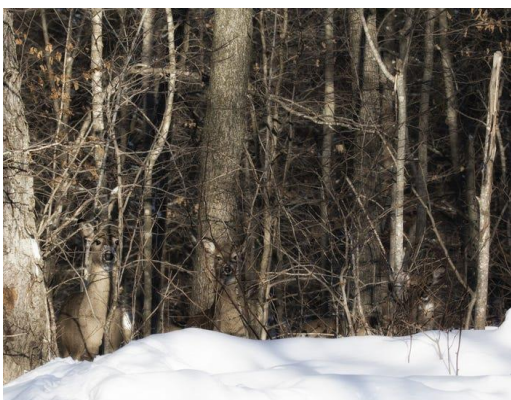
Maths – After half term, we will be looking at the strategies involved in multiplication, with a focus on 2s, 5s and 10 times tables.

The class of the week was **Milne** with **25,280,658** points in a single week!

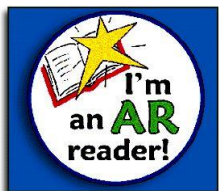


AR Class of the Week

The class of the week this week was **Milne** with **604** combined points in 90 seconds!

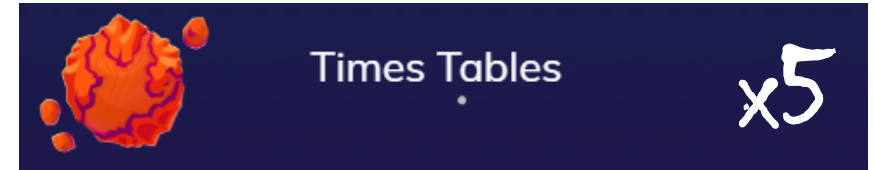
