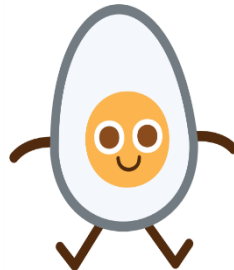

Maths

This week we will be working on comparing quantities, counting on and back from a given number. We will also be looking at and finding one more / one fewer and ordering numbers to 10.

This week we will be making a bird's nest using natural resources.

Topic

What material would be the best?" The children will be making predictions and then investigate. "What happened? Why?" "How do we know? Explain. The children will also be using their oracy skills when talking about different shoes and their purposes.
