

Nursery rhyme of the week: The Transport song




<u>Maths</u>

Number of the week: 5

Shape of the week: This week we will be revisiting the following shapes: square, circle, rectangle and triangle. We will count the sides and corners and look for these shapes within the environment.

Activities: We will be practising our counting to 5. We will use different countables to help us as well as counting claps and jumps. When using counters, the children will be encouraged to place in different arrangements as well as on a five frame. We will also look at what the numeral 5 looks like.
