Dear Parents/Carers,

To celebrate all the children's hard work, we have hoping, on Friday 17th May (the Friday at the end of SATs Week), to take Year 6 to Legoland Windsor!

With over 55 rides, attractions and live shows,

Legoland has something for everyone and we're sure that this will definitely be a day to remember!

We appreciate that this is not a cheap activity but we do think it's good value for money and feel that the children deserve to let loose after working so hard!

Tickets would usually cost £66 to buy on the day, however, we have been offered a reduced price of just £8.75 per child! The cost of the coach is approximately £25 per child, however the PTFA have generously offered to donate £5 per child to help to reduce the total cost for parents. **We are therefore asking for parents to pay a maximum contribution of £28.75 for this visit.**



We'll send out more specific details closer to the time but we're planning to leave at approximately 7:30am and will be back around 8pm. Children will need to bring a packed meal to have at lunchtime while we're at the park, another packed meal to have on the way home and some spending money if you'd like them to have some! Children will be in small groups and with an adult throughout the day.

This visit will not be available on ParentPay until we have gauged whether parents are able to contribute to the cost of the trip. As you may already know, we have recently cancelled other educational visits due to a lack of parental pledges. However, we need parents to be honest about how much they will be able to pay towards the visit. The school does have a small fund to supplement educational visits however as this does not fall within our curriculum remit, there is not much leeway in how much shortfall we will be able to absorb.

If the trip goes ahead, we ask that all payments are made by **Friday 10th May**, the week before the visit.

Please respond to the link below to confirm whether you would be willing to pay the full amount, part of the amount or do not wish for your child to go on the trip. The link will be live until Monday 11th March. We will then be able to confirm whether we are able to go ahead with the trip and it will be available to pay on ParentPay!
