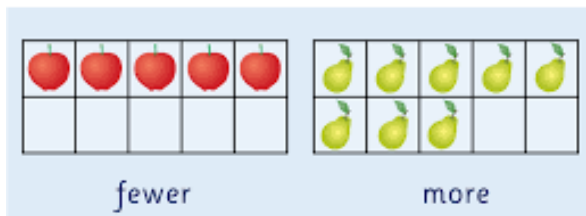

Activities:

This week in maths the children will be introduced to the vocabulary 'more' and 'fewer'. We will use real life objects in hoops to identify which has more and fewer and then encourage the children to use this language.



Topic

- Explore the word 'forest' and create our own forest scene
- Construction- building a den for the wolf and a cottage for Grandma
- Use playdough to make items to put in Grandma's basket
- Creative- make a new cape for Little Red Riding Hood
- Make a map for Little Red riding hood to follow. The children will also create maps of the nursery environment for their friends to follow!
