We are absolutely thrilled to announce our '**potential**' Year 2 trip to Warwick Castle! The trip will take place on **Friday 5th July 2024**. We plan to depart from school at **9:00am** and will be back for the end of the school day (hopefully).

Next half term, we will be studying a brand new topic about the monarchy. We will follow the timeline of the monarchy and look at different rulers in detail. During this time, we will look at castle life and what was involved in this. We will also be looking at how to attack and defend our very own castles.

During our visit to Warwick Castle, we will explore the Great Hall, watch the bowman in action, get lost in the Horrible Histories Maze, walk through the Peacock Garden and watch the incredible Falconer's Quest.



We will also take part in a 'Castle Life' workshop. In this workshop, the children will grind corn, spin cotton and learn a medieval game as they explore what life was like for everyday castle folk.

From looking at the website, the regular 'on the day' entry fee to Warwick castle is usually **£39**. However, we have managed to negotiate the castle, workshop and the coach journey for a combined total of **£23!**

We think it will be a fantastic day out and the trip will help the children to be immersed in our topic. We hope the children are as excited as the staff are!
