Dear parents /carers,

Thank you so much for filling in the promise to pay form so quickly, we're delighted to announce that we will definitely be heading off to Blists Hill Victorian Town on Monday 17th June!

Blists Hill allows us to step back in time to the dawn of the modern age. We get to experience what everyday life was like in 1900 and see how technological advances and industry were changing people's lives. Added to this we can visit Victorian shops and cottages, meet craftspeople demonstrating their trades and experience what life was like in a Victorian school.

The museum asks that we do not dress up for this trip, however, we will be changing into Victorian school child outfits before we head off to the school room. These are **provided by Blists Hill** and are only worn for the hour duration of the workshop, just long enough for us to get some fantastic pictures!

The trip will take place within the school day so normal drop off and pick up times apply. Please can your child **wear school uniform**, wear sensible shoes (there's a lot of walking!) and bring a raincoat as there is only limited shelter if it rains. They will also need a **packed lunch** in a bag, with a water bottle and a **maximum of £5 spending money** in a labelled purse or bag, **if you wish them to have this**. We visit the sweet shop and toy shop where items can be bought for £5 and under. Teachers will collect money in in the morning and hand it out in the shops as needed. Please note that we can't take responsibility for missing money if a child has not handed it in.
