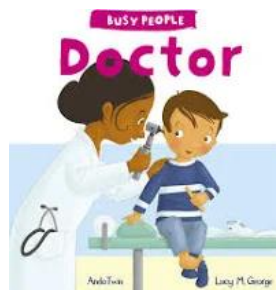

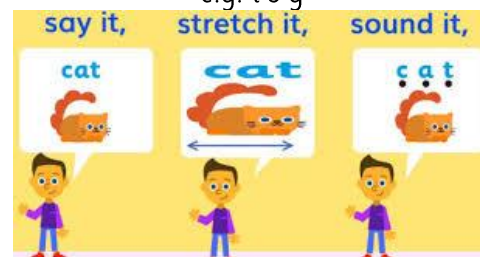

Phonics

This week in phonics the children are beginning to listen to phonemes (the sound that the letter makes) and blending words together. This week we will read the story 'oi frog' and look at the places the animals are. We will then listen to the phonemes and blend the word together.

e.g. l-o-g

Shape of the week: cube

These are the sentences the children will learn about cubes
