Where do 'or' and 'ore' appear in our words?

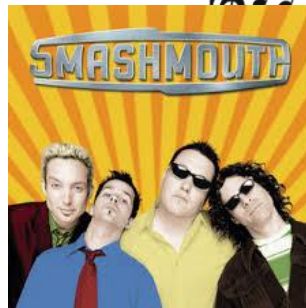


