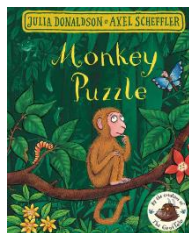

The boring (but extremely important) bits for parents and carers...

- Tickets are on sale on ParentPay now and will close at midnight on Monday 2nd December. We don't have a limit to how many tickets are available but the deadline to purchase tickets cannot be extended so please book before 2nd December to avoid disappointment.
- The Winter Wonderland for children in Reception, Year One and Year Two will be from 3:00 to 4:45. Children will be collected from their usual classroom doors. The Winter Wonderland for children in Years Three-Six will be from 5:05 to 7:00. This session is slightly longer to ensure that children aren't stuck queuing when their first activity begins at 5:15. Children will be dropped off at the main office and must be collected by an adult from their usual classroom doors. Please bring a torch for the 7pm pick-up.
- Our event coincides with the school's Christmas Jumper Day, therefore, the children will already be in their festive gear, even if coming straight after school.
- If your child has any specific dietary requirements, this information must be provided when booking a ticket.
- The PTFA has set aside a limited number of tickets at a reduced rate for families who are struggling to cover costs at the moment.
