Dear Parent and Carers,

We have been notified that Worcestershire County Council have again granted permission for the new building development opposite the Leisure Centre to install 2-way temporary traffic lights onto Stourport Road for the next week.

This will have a significant impact on what is already an incredibly congested road at the start and end of school. We appeal to parent and carers who drop their child to school to do so at Blackstone Car Park and avoid Stourport Road entirely.

With coaches and other vehicles using Stourport Road, the risk to students is greatly increased with parked vehicles on either side of the road, as well as temporary traffic lights.

We appeal to all parent and carers, wherever possible, to not park on or use Stourport Road for the next week while the temporary lights are in place. This will impact access to the Leisure Centre Car Park, as well as Stourport Road.

We thank families for their support in advance with making Stourport Road as safe as possible for our students over the coming weeks.

We are liaising with the development and Worcestershire County Council to try and minimise the impact of these works.
